MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Marcus Antonio Mack respectfully requests an extension of a **final thirty (30) days, until August 22, 2018**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Marcus Antonio Mack respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the


2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Justin Jermaine Johnson with the Supreme Court on May 23, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.






