RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THEIR FINAL BRIEF

For the reasons set forth below (vacation out of the country), Counsel for Respondents respectfully request that this court grant Respondents an additional twenty (20) days' time to file the Respondents' Final Brief in this matter, giving Respondents a total of forty (40) days to file their Final Brief from the date the Appellant files her Record on Appeal.

Factual Basis for Motion

1. Appellant's initial reply brief was filed and served on July 3rd, 2018.
2. The deadline for filing and serving the Record on Appeal in this matter is therefore August 3rd, 2018.
3. Counsel for the Respondents will be out of the country on vacation from Wednesday August 1, 2018, until Saturday August 18, 2018.



4. Counsel therefore expects that the Record on Appeal will be filed during counsel's vacation, making it impossible and/or impracticable for counsel to complete and copy the final brief within 20 days of service of the Record on Appeal.


