Good afternoon. I received your email today (copied below) in reference to transcripts in the above captioned case. Please note for future correspondence that I am replying on my sccourts email. I have reviewed my records and do not have any requests prior to this one for the April 9-10, 2018 trial of the State v Dazzelle Smith or the May 18, 2018 Motion for new trial. I was the court reporter for both.

I estimate that a transcript of the April 9-10, 2018 trial will be approximately 270 pages at a cost of \$3.25 per page for a total of \$877.50. I estimate that a transcript of the May 11, 2018 hearing will be approximately 20 pages at a cost of \$3.25 per page for a total of \$65.00.
