

- Magistrate Courts and Municipal Courts are required to process expungements for charges that were dismissed or where the person was found not guilty in their courts. I understand that I will need to contact the individual Courts to determine the application procedures. Charges dismissed in General Sessions Court will be processed by the Solicitor's Office.
- Applications are processed in the order in which they are received. An application does not guarantee that the charge(s) can be removed from my criminal record. Once my application has been reviewed, I will be notified by letter if additional information or fees are needed.

Fees

- I understand that some applications for expungement will require a non-refundable \$250 administrative fee, a \$25 SLED verification fee and a \$35 Clerk of Court filing fee. All fees are non-refundable regardless of whether the offense is determined to be statutorily ineligible for expungement or the Solicitor or his designee does not consent to the expungement. All fees must be paid by money order or a cashier's check. Fee requirements were established by the South Carolina Legislature on June 3, 2009.



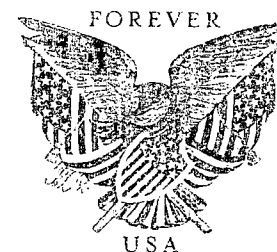

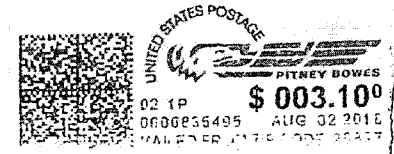
