Upon reviewing your filing dated July 25, 2018, which this Court construes as an attempt to file the record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The personal data identifiers and other sensitive information have not been redacted as required by the Supreme Court's Order dated April 15, 2014, which can be found at [www.sccourts.org/courtOrders/HTMLFiles/2014-04-15-02.htm](http://www.sccourts.org/courtOrders/HTMLFiles/2014-04-15-02.htm).
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the page numbers go only to page 268. All documents after that page have not been numbered.
- The record on appeal must contain a cover page containing the caption, title of the document, and both the appellant's information and respondents' counsel's information, pursuant to Rule 267(a), SCACR. Please be advised that the caption must match exactly with the one given below:

Nathaniel Alston, Claimant, Appellant,

v.

All My Son's Moving & Storage, Employer, and Vanliner Insurance Company, Carrier, Respondents.

- The record on appeal must contain an index which gives the names and page numbers for the enclosed documents, pursuant to Rule 210(e), SCACR.
- The number of copies provided is not in compliance with the SCACR. Please provide fourteen (14) bound copies.
- The document is not accompanied by the certificate of counsel, required by Rule 210(g), SCACR.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide proof of service for the record on appeal, not the designation of matter. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must serve and file an amended record on appeal, along with a certificate of counsel and a proof of service within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed.
