

ORDER

On August 6, 2018, appellant Lisa Fisher filed an Emergency Motion for Clarification of Briefing Schedule and to Consolidate Appellate Record, requesting the Court clarify whether we had consolidated the issues in the four notices of appeal filed by appellants in this case (Appellate Case No. 2018-000566). As we stated in our order dated April 10, 2018, and again in our order dated August 2, 2018, "Any appeal from the order ruling on the Rule 59 motion shall be combined with this appeal." As a result, in our August 2 order setting the expedited briefing schedule, we found it unnecessary to reiterate in any more explicit detail that the four notices of appeal—collectively involving the appeals from the will contest and constructive trust trials, sanctions against Betty and Lisa Fisher, and Rule 59 motions—had already been consolidated and would require one record and one set of briefs.
