of this request, counsel shows:





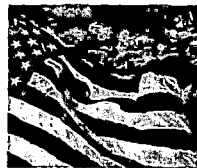
