Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I'm in receipt of Deputy Clerk V. Claire Allen's letter dated 7/30/18, in which I received today, 8/6/18 (front cover copy of envelope enclosed showing date received). The letter states that the court is in receipt of a CD which was filed along with my record on appeal. That the CD is said to contain the parole hearing dated November 15, 2017. That the CD is not able to be played.

Madam Clerk, that is one of my issues on appeal, and my argument as well. SCDPPPS issued the CD to me in which I paid over \$17.00 for, and it arrived to me distorted. The Court must order the Respondent's to provide a CD that is audible without any distortion of the hearing dated 11/15/17.

Please be advise that I'm not able to provide the court a CD within 10 days of the 30th, because SCDPPPS require another \$17.00, and it's more likely it will be distorted as well. Furthermore, SCDC mailroom official Ms. Amason had the CD in her possession until I mailed to your office. If the CD has any other inaudible distortions your office may have to contact Ms. Amason regarding the lack of care of the CD while in her care. When the CD initially arrived here at the institution, the mail room official Ms. Amason kept it in her possession until the chaplain receive it from her, at which time the chaplain allows me to hear the CD at the chaplain, afterwards, he return it back to the mailroom, and Ms. Amason held the CD until I mailed it along with my record on appeal.

SCDPPPS did not provide me a CD that did not allow me access to the parole hearing, which is one of mine main arguments and claims. I should not have to be held under penalty or default that will result in the dismissal of my appeal because of SCDPPPS not allowing you nor me access to the 11/15/17 parole hearing. Time is required to receive another CD, but it's my belief that the Court should order SCDPPPS a CD that will allow the Court access to the 11/15/17 parole hearing.

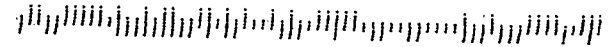

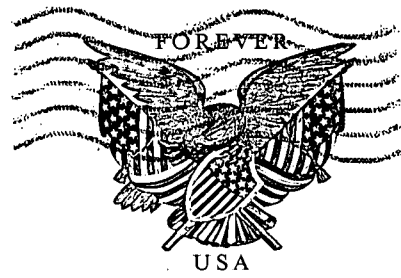
