

ORDER

This appeal arises out of the appellant's conviction and sentence imposed on June 6, 2018. The notice of appeal was served on June 28, 2018, which is more than ten days after imposition of the sentence. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. *See State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 784 S.E.2d 690 (Ct. App. 2016) (noting the requirement of service of the notice of appeal is jurisdictional and the appellate court lacks jurisdiction to extend or ignore the deadline for service); Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR ("After a plea or trial resulting in conviction or a proceeding resulting in revocation of probation, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after the sentence is imposed."). The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
