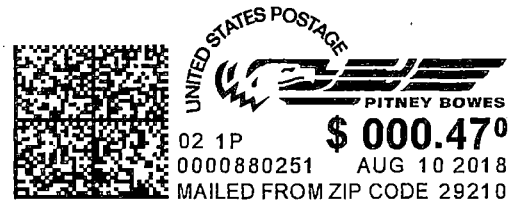
My name is Jason K. Sherman I am responding to the Appellate Case No. 2018-001162 on behalf of the arguable basis that there are Issues Preserved for appeal Rule 203(d)(2)(B)(IV). Ralph Wilson Jr. did not advise me properly, when I was sentenced to Fifteen (15) years to the South Carolina Department of Correction in June 13, 2018. I was

He also advised me that I had no case in the matter sign the plea or he would step down from being my Attorney. He had already threatened to step down April 9, 2018. Which we actually went to court May 30, 2018, but some reason I still do not know why he stays as my Attorney. But on May 30, 2018 the Judge placed me back in jail for no apparent reason. I had complied to the rules of my bond in the court room when the Judge remanded me back to jail. Ralph Wilson Jr., and my Solicitor Lauree Richardson Ortiz both of them were shocked and ask the Judge could they approach the bench. To discuss the Judge decision but I still ended up in jail. I had to remake bail over again which I thought was odd I bonded out with the same bail company. That I use the first time, which she Presicella says had no knowledge why the Judge would do what he did do to the fact that I had complied to the condition of my bail. Ms. Presicella says also advised me that she thought I should get another Attorney. Also I received paper work from Presicella says of all my court appearance.
