MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.





Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Leonard Jenkins v. The State with this Court on June 18, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Dominique Cash v. The State with this Court on June 13, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Laurie Hollis v. The State with this Court on June 6, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. 


