
Dear Ms. Jessica Lucas:

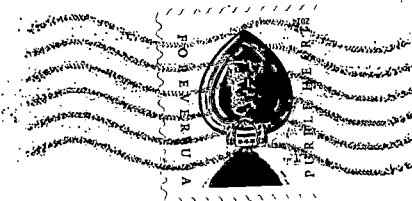
