
Re: State of South Carolina v. Larry Cornish - Appellate Case No. 2017-001866

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above case are due to be served and filed on August 17, 2018. However, I discovered while reading the transcript and taking notes for my brief that we are missing pages 89 and 90 of the trial transcript. These missing pages, the best I can tell, contain the videotape of the arrest being played for the judge during the Jackson v. Denno hearing, and part of counsel's cross-examination on why the Miranda warnings on the videotape were insufficient.

We have requested this transcript today, and I would request that the time limits be held in abeyance pending receipt of it. A copy of our transcript request is attached. I will notify the Court immediately upon receipt of the missing pages, and I will file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter within seven days of receipt of these pages if that meets with the approval of this Court. 
