Dear Ms. Kitchings,

I begin by emphasizing that my inquiry here be considered as an investigative recourse to resolve a previous causation that may have resulted in several negligible violations of law, right, and procedure that directly influenced the "due process" of my appeal and considerable rulings in my case.

* Please provide copy of said request.

4) In the attached document dated March 26, 2015, your court responded to an "explanation for appealing" by my appointed counsel, where you (the court) stated: "This court has reviewed" it. What were the contents of that explanation for appealing (see attachment).

* Please provide copies of contents.



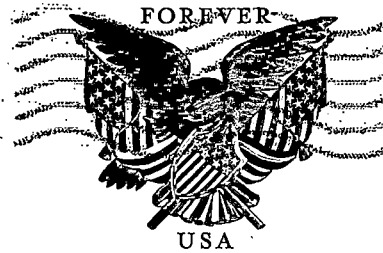
