The attention of the parties is directed to the order relating to the inclusion of


personal data identifiers and other sensitive information in documents filed with the Supreme Court of South Carolina and the South Carolina Court of Appeals. The order can be found at

For this matter to proceed, it will be necessary for you to provide the following within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.

- (1) A proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been served on the counsel for the respondent as required by Rules 243(b) and 203(d)(1)(B)(i), SCACR.
- (2) A written statement as to the date on which you received written notice of entry of the order dated November 30, 2018. This order was apparently filed with the clerk of the circuit court on December 8, 2017.<sup>1</sup>
