MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Maurice Demon Mitchell, respectfully requests a **fourth and final** thirty (30) days **until September 17, 2018**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Maurice Demon Mitchell, respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Nathan Good with the Court of Appeals on July 23, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Charles Winston, Jr. with the Supreme Court on July 20, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Tommy McGee with the Court of Appeals on July 17, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Maurice A. Odom with the Court of Appeals on July 12, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State in the case of Jonta Green v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 10, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jonta Green v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on July 10, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Henry Delos Anderson v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on June 25, 2018. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of David W. Dover v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on June 13, 2018.






