I'm writing concerning my Appellate, I never received the Remittitur on Feb. 2016. I was told about this on 4/14/2018 from the Town of Summerville. I was released from jail then to take care of this, if I had received the Remittitur I would've filed a motion. I was trying to resolve this matter at that time. I'm disable and my home had damages from the disasters from 2015 until 2017. I have health issue that my doctor is trying to control. I had issues with the mail at my home. I had my mail on hold on some months of 2016 and 2017 due to the condition of my home and mail. I never had a fair court appearance on this case I was found guilty after I contacted the Court in Summerville advising them that I was coming to appear in court and that I lived in another County and that I was lost, the GPS was helping until my phone went dead and was defective at the time. I told the judge I was innocent after he asked how do I plea, I was told I was guilty. I asked for another date trial and a Public Defender. I also wrote letters to Judge Turner and I was told that he was retired. I filed a appeal about this and I never received the Remittitur. I never had a fair court date for this I was found guilty for being late but the Judge still saw me on Dec. 2014. I'm innocent of the charge. The court has proof of me calling them advising the court that I was on the way to

the court. I was entitled to another date, jury trial and Public Defender the Judge never gave me those rights that I have. I was aware of the Remand on April 14, 2018 from Summerville. I was picked up on April 13, 2018 and released from Judge Whittenton on April 14, 2018. I was told to write a letter explaining this. I would've have a Appellate Defender help me due to me being disable. I have proof of my mail was being tampered with and I had my mail on hold ~~some~~ months of 2016 and 2017 and I advised the Postal Service about it. I WAS given a case # as well.
