



ORDER

Jaques J. Sullivan has filed a suppression motion pursuant to the South Carolina Homeland Security Act (the Act).¹ The motion is denied because this court lacks jurisdiction over a habeas corpus action filed in federal court. *See Limehouse v. Hulsey*, 404 S.C. 93, 104, 744 S.E.2d 566, 572 (2013) ("Although federal and state courts form one system of jurisprudence, federal courts have no general supervisory power over the state courts, and there is nothing a state court can do to affect federal practice and procedure." (quoting 21 C.J.S. *Courts* § 274 (Supp. 2013))).
