
ORDER

Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief was denied by Justice James. This Court dismissed the Notice of Appeal for failure to establish when Justice James' order was received and failure to show service of the Notice of Appeal was timely. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order issued by Judge Brown finding petitioner was entitled to a belated review of Justice James' order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).

Based on the vote of the Court: (1) the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Brown's order is granted, with no further briefing required; and (2) after an *Austin* review of Justice James' order, the petition for a writ of certiorari from Justice James' order is denied.
