Dear Mr. Crump:

The Court has received your letter dated August 14, 2018, in which you are inquiring about what was filed on your behalf by your counsel of record and requesting copies of documents from your appellate case.

A notice of appeal, dated March 9, 2015, was received from attorney C. Timothy Sullivan, Jr. on March 11, 2015. The Court sent a deficiency letter on March 13, 2015, requesting a guilty plea explanation from Mr. Sullivan, pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Mr. Sullivan's explanation was received on March 25, 2015 and the Court then sent a letter on March 26, 2015 advising Mr. Sullivan to forward his explanation to you, along with a statement that you had twenty days from the date of his letter to file your own explanation with the Court. The Court received an explanation from you on April 14, 2015 and proceeded to review both your explanation and Mr. Sullivan's explanation. The Court found that a sufficient explanation was not provided and dismissed your appeal on May 15, 2015. The remittitur was then issued in a timely manner pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR, on June 2, 2015, effectively ending the Court's jurisdiction over this appeal.

It is the policy of this Court to receive a copying fee before mailing the requested copies. The costs for a copy of your case file are as follows: 22 pages @ \$.25 per page, which equals \$5.50 and a postage fee of \$.98 for a total of \$6.48.
