
to dismiss appeal be extended to September 3, 2018.





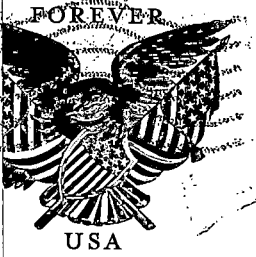
