I've written a complaint against appointed appellate attorney Robert M. Dudek, Esq.

August 27, 2018. Counsel is denying me my guaranteed South Carolina and United States Constitutional right to "Access to the Courts" by refusing to petition the South Carolina Supreme Court for 'Bail Pending Appellate Review', pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rules: Rule, 243(K) - formally Rule, 227(K) SCACR. I can not submit substantial documents pro se since I am represented by counsel. Miller v. State, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010).
