A defendant who enters a guilty plea on the advice of counsel may attack the voluntary and intelligent character of the plea, on the grounds of ineffective assistance only by showing that counsel's representation fell below an objective standard of reasonableness and that there is a reasonable probability that, but for counsel's errors, the defendant would not have pled guilty but would have insisted on going to trial. USCA Const. Amend 6 Joseph

v. State Supreme Court of South Carolina

35/SC 551 571 SE 2d 280 Because

in the Appellant's indictment was for Armed Robbery why would the Appellant sign a plea for what he was indicted for. If he had the proper knowledge from counsel he would have only pled to the lesser included offense which is strong arm robbery.

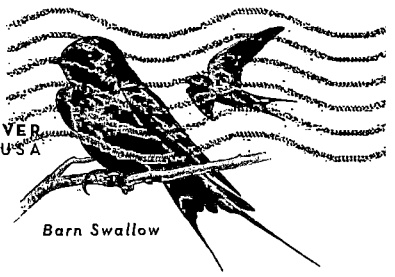
