**ORDER REVISING AND CLARIFYING ORDER
 FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Upon receiving and considering Defendants' Motion to Reconsider Award of Treble Damages, Clarify Prior Ruling, and Confirm that Wage Payment Claim has been Adjudicated in its Entirety, the Court finds as follows:

1. Defendants' motion to reconsider the Court's earlier order awarding treble damages is denied. My earlier award of \$31,200.00, plus costs and attorneys' fees, remains in place.
2. By this order, I clarify that my earlier grant of partial summary judgment was against the Defendant The Shaw Corporation d/b/a Shaw's Pharmacy and not against Defendant Charles Cleburn Turner, because Defendant Turner was not a party to the prior South Carolina Department of Labor Licensing and Regulation ("LLR") proceeding brought by Plaintiff.
3. Finally, I clarify that my order is for summary judgment on all of Plaintiff's claims that relate to unpaid wages. In the earlier LLR proceeding, Plaintiff sought unpaid wages in the amount of \$96,000, and LLR found she was entitled to \$10,400. I have previously ruled that the parties had a full and fair opportunity to litigate the issue of Hewitt's unpaid wages at the LLR level and that the purpose of Hewitt's LLR investigation determined the exact claims asserted in this lawsuit. Therefore, I find that all of Plaintiff's claims relating to unpaid wages

have been adjudicated in their entirety and Plaintiff may not seek additional unpaid wages from any Defendant in the instant action.
