The Court is in receipt of your correspondence received by fax in this office on September 3, 2018. In your correspondence, you mention the Court's letter of August 8, 2018. The Court's letter of August 8 was sent to notify you that the time for serving and filing your respondent's initial brief had expired. You also mention that you have not provided a reply brief.
