ORDER

Appellant has served a notice of appeal from an order of the Administrative Law Court (ALC), which remands the case back to the South Carolina Department of Corrections for consideration of whether Appellant is eligible for the supervised furlough program. Because the ALC's order remands the case, it is not a final decision that is immediately appealable pursuant to section 1-23-610 of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2017). *See Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority v. South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. Appellant may appeal after a final decision. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
