This letter is to request a 14-day extension of time in which to file the Final Appellant's Brief of Respondent-Appellant, Final Respondent's Brief of Respondent-Appellant and Final Reply Brief of Respondent-Appellant with regard to the above referenced appeal. In preparing the final briefs, I note there are issues with Record on Appeal, as prepared, that need to be addressed with opposing counsel.

Specifically, during the preparation of the Final Briefs, I first realized that counsel for the Appellant-Respondent must not have obtained the trial exhibits from the Administrative Law Court to include copies of the actual exhibits in the Record on Appeal. None of the exhibits in the Record on Appeal as prepared contain the trial exhibit stickers, and many of the exhibits include handwritten notes that I do not believe were part of the original exhibits. Without the exhibit stickers, or at least some type of divider page between exhibits, it is impossible to tell where one exhibit begins and ends. I am having great difficulty working with the Record on Appeal for this reason, and I am concerned the judges on the panel will encounter the very same problems. I intend to try to work out some resolution with opposing counsel. Otherwise, a motion may be needed.

By my calculations, the Final Appellant's Brief of Respondent-Appellant, Final Respondent's Brief of Respondent-Appellant and Final Reply Brief of Respondent-Appellant will now be due on or before September 24, 2018. I have not enclosed a filing fee for this request because the Respondent-Appellant South Carolina Department of Public Safety is exempt. If you require a formal motion, please advise.
