September 9, 2018 – Returned call to Mrs./Ms. Jordan at approximately 8 pm EDT. Mrs./Ms. Jordan was not the Court Reporter for **January 24, 2018**. She will research the matter and call the Appellant on September 10, 2018 while she is in Orangeburg.

Dear Mrs./Ms. Richardson,

Please forgive me for suspending the customary pleasantries and going directly to the reason for this letter. In conversations with knowledgeable people that work for...or ...are employed by Orangeburg County; i.e., the Clerk of Court, the Secretary for the Master-In-Equity and the Court Reporter, it is now believed that you are the Court Reporter that was present in Judge Jackson's Courtroom on January 24, 2018. According to Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, in appeals from the court of common pleas, masters-in-equity, special referees or the family court in domestic actions, a transcript must be ordered within ten (10) days after the date of service of the notice of appeal. The date of service for my appeal is July 18, 2018, that is dated July 14, 2018.

Unfortunately, there were unexpected delays in contacting you for a variety of reasons. Even now, no one I talked to can confirm with certainty that you are the Court Reporter that was at the hearing on **January 24, 2018**. However, consistent with the Rules, if you are the Court Reporter, I need to order transcripts for the hearing that was held in the Honorable James B. Jackson, Jr.'s Courtroom on **January 24, 2018** either under Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. v. Dorothy Sistrunk or C.A. Case #. 2008-CP-38-1024:

Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR also states the following in pertinent parts, "[A]ppellant shall contemporaneously furnish all parties, the Office of Court Administration, and the clerk of the appellate court with copies of all correspondence with the court reporter. The court reporter must acknowledge receipt of the request by responding to the appellant within five business days." 207(a)(2) adds the following in pertinent parts, "[T]he court reporter shall transcribe and deliver the transcript to appellant no later than sixty (60) days after the date of the request. Records shall be transcribed by the court reporter in the order in which the requests for transcripts are made."

If you are not the Court Reporter that was in Court on the date in question, please direct me to the person that was present. Thank you in advance for acting on my request. My contact information is in the letterhead. You can also reach me on my cell phone at **803-614-1093**.
