
**RESPONDENT QUALITY BUILT, LLC'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE



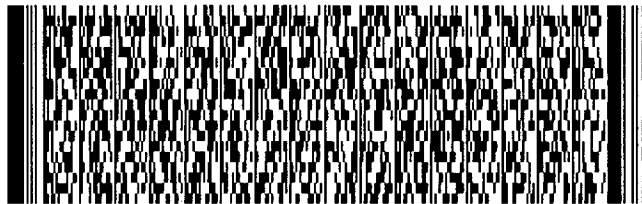
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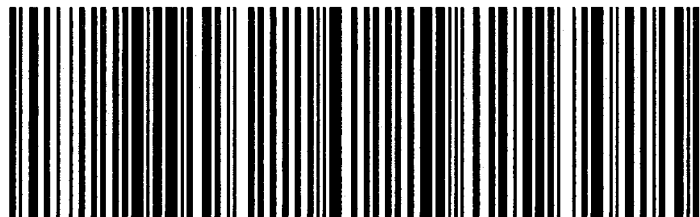
