ORDER

First, Respondents' motion to dismiss is denied. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that is paginated throughout the entire record with page numbers beginning on the first page. The amended record on appeal must also include an index.

Second, this court construes Appellant's September 17, 2018 filing as a motion to stay a Workers' Compensation Commission hearing scheduled for September 27, 2018 at noon. Because this court has limited information before it relating to the subject of the hearing, the motion is denied. This court notes, however, that the Workers Compensation Commission may not proceed with matters affected by this appeal. *See* Rule 205, SCACR ("Upon the service of the notice of appeal, the appellate court shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the appeal; the lower court or administrative tribunal shall have jurisdiction to entertain petitions for writs of supersedeas as provided by Rule 241. Nothing in these Rules shall prohibit the lower court, commission or tribunal from proceeding with matters not affected by the appeal.").
