Counsel for James Lamont Arthur, respectfully requests a **fourth and final** thirty (30) days **until October 29, 2018**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for James Lamont Arthur, respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Odom with the Supreme Court on September 17, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Maurice Demon Mitchell with the Court of Appeals on September 17, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Guadalupe Guzman Morales with the Court of Appeals on September 17, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Richard F.V. Bowman III v. The State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on August 29, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Tony Lametrius Leamon with the Court of Appeals on August 28, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Steven Louis Barnes with the Court of Appeals on August 22, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Phillip Antoine


Stackhouse with the Court of Appeals on August 17, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Ralph Joel Burns with the Court of Appeals on July 30, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension** until **October 29, 2018**, in which to file the brief in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.




