MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Johnny Tamar Brown respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until October 31, 2018**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. 
4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.




