Dear Mr. Wilson,

I am responding to your letter dated September 21, 2018.

First: You – Your Office, Or rather your Lawyers, had a previous Constitutional Challenge Dismissed without prejudice on the grounds that I served you Certified Mail but I did not serve you Certified Mail – Restricted Delivery, so the Judge refused to hear the Constitutional Challenge because of your Lawyers argument, I did not serve it Restricted delivery to you. This Constitutional Challenge of Laws made in Violation of the South Carolina Constitution was served to you **Restricted Delivery** to you personally. Pleas Defend the Integrity of the Constitution you gave an OATH to Defend.. Theodore Wagner..Appellant v. Designa Print and Mike Davis including anyone who is Complicit or Enabled protecting Mike Davis....Respondent. Case: No 2018-001125. I would like to have all Laws, Rules, or anything else that Oppresses the Citizen of Poverty from the same Full and Fair Redress of Grievances as every other Citizen. The Court of Appeals Rules use indirect restraints to Oppress my access to an Appeal and Challenge each one that does.

As a Citizen of South Carolina **In this Challenge of Court of Appeal Rules, etc**, I am clear that I am Challenging the Court of Laws made in Violation of Article 1, Section 2 of the South Carolina

Constitution and / or actions used in Violation of Article 1, Section 2 of the South Carolina Constitution's 5th Sentence that states **"5) The General Assembly shall make no law respecting the right of the people to peaceable petition the Government or any department thereof for a redress of grievances".** **The Department of Justice,** or who ever makes **Challenge of Court of Appeal Rules, etc, the Court of Appeal Rules, etc, Oppress and deny me access to this judicial process.** I am not asking for you to represent me **but rather the South Carolina Constitution and the U. S. Constitution as under USA vs. BUTLER, 297 US 1 (1936)** and other cases quoted are upheld.

Second: Your letters says it best. **"This Office, by law, is restricted to advising ... Officials."** I sent you Evidence of Crimes committed by persons working in there Official Capacity. I have tried as a poor citizen of South Carolina to end the Lie Started by Detective William Crews to cover up **Andrea Crisel** was 20 years, 1 Month, 16 Days old on June 25, 1999 when he testified to may Lies under Oath. **"This Office, by law, is restricted to advising ... Officials."** Then advise the proper Government Officials to figure out the Dates and end the Ongoing Conspiracy to call my wife who was 20 years old on that day and hosted yer party a victim. It is Government Officials facilitating this Conspiracy. Advise them to fix it.

Third: I also so Evidence that show Crimes that a South Carolina Probation Officer refused to use his authority to enforce a Permanent Restraining Order by the Government to Protect Rich Defendants that I do not believe the court should knowingly be able to cover up. **"This Office, by law, is restricted to advising ... Officials."** Then advise the Proper Government Officials to investigate the cover up.

The Oath of Office, **ARTICLE VI. OFFICER, SECTION 5.** and the wording "and that I will, to the best of my ability, discharge the duties thereof, **and preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of this State and of the United States. So help me God."** would give the Attorney General the authority to not only advise these ... Officials, but also **preserve, protect, and defend the**

Constitution of this State and of the United States. I have made a Constitutional Challenge that as a Disabled poor person on Disability who are restricted from the Appeals process, especial to cover up Government Crimes. Your one letter stated "This Office, by law, is restricted to advising ... Officials." Your own letter and your Oath of Office give you this Authority.



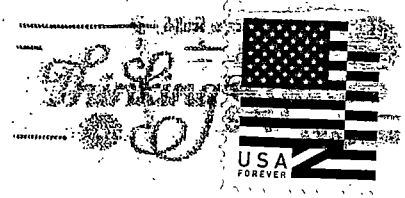
