Mellette, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Tyrone Christopher King, did within this county and state on the August 31st, 2016 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on August 31st, 2016 at approximately 2:20 a.m., while at 237-B America St., which is within the City and County of Charleston, SC, the above named defendant, Tyrone Christopher King, did willfully, knowingly and unlawfully violate section 16-21-60 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (Use of Vehicle Without Consent) to wit:

During a verbal argument with the victim (Tyyentle King [the defendant's sister]), which took place in the victim's home, the defendant became enraged and bit the victim in the face, pushed her and then grabbed a butcher knife from the kitchen. The defendant approached the victim with the knife and the victim attempted to flee up the stairs but fell while trying to do so. The defendant then stabbed the victim in the left side of her face with the butcher knife, in the area between her left temple and left eye. After the attack, the defendant fled the scene in the victim's 2000 Ford Crown Victoria (SC Tag # MNA 293/ VIN 2FAFP71W7YX193428), without the victim's (vehicle owner per the SCDMV) permission. At the scene, near the stairs where the assault took place, a large butcher knife was found on the floor. The victim's wound required treatment at MUSC. The incident was witnessed by a person (to be named later) who corroborated the victim's account of the events. The victim positively identified the defendant (her brother) as her attacker and the person that fled the scene in her vehicle in a single photograph. As of this date, September 1st, 2016, the vehicle has not been returned to the victim and the vehicle's current whereabouts are unknown.

The above is true and believable based on the statements of the victim and witness, the victim's injuries, the positive identification of the defendant by the victim, the crime scene and the investigation conducted by the Charleston Police Department.

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, Detective M. Mellette, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Tyrone Christopher King, did within this county and state on the August 31st, 2016 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on August 31st, 2016 at approximately 2:20 a.m., while at 237-B America St., which is within the City and County of Charleston, SC, the above named defendant, Tyrone Christopher King, did willfully, knowingly and unlawfully violate section 16-3-600 (C) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (Assault & Battery 1st Degree) to wit:

During a verbal argument with the victim (Tyyentle King [the defendant's sister]), which took place in the victim's home, the defendant became enraged and bit the victim in the face, pushed her and then grabbed a butcher knife from the kitchen. The defendant approached the victim with the knife and the victim attempted to flee up the stairs but fell while trying to do so. The defendant then stabbed the victim in the left side of her face with the butcher knife, in the area between her left temple and left eye. The victim also sustained a defensive wound (laceration) to her finger. After the attack, the defendant fled the scene in the victim's 2000 Ford Crown Victoria (SC Tag # MNA 293/ VIN 2FAFP71W7YX193428), without the victim's (vehicle owner's) permission. At the scene, near the stairs where the assault took place, a large butcher knife was found on the floor. The victim's wound required treatment at MUSC. The incident was witnessed by a person (to be named later) who corroborated the victim's account of the events. The victim positively identified the defendant (her brother) as her attacker in a single photograph. This assault (stabbing) to the victim's head was accomplished by means (a butcher knife) likely to produce great bodily injury to the victim.

The above is true and believable based on the statements of the victim and witness, the victim's injuries, the positive identification of the defendant by the victim, the crime scene and the investigation conducted by the Charleston Police Department.
