ORDER

Respondent's motion to dismiss is granted. The order on appeal granting a motion to change venue is not immediately appealable. *See Godley v. Uniroyal, Inc.*, 278 S.C. 571, 572, 300 S.E.2d 78, 78 (1983) ("It is generally held that an order granting or refusing a change of venue is interlocutory and therefore not immediately appealable."); *Breland v. Love Chevrolet Olds, Inc.*, 339 S.C. 89, 94-95, 529 S.E.2d 11, 14 (2000) ("[S]ince any venue error will be correctable upon appeal after trial, we find the right of proper venue has not been affected such that the order would be immediately appealable.").
