The Chief Appellate Defender has reviewed the Affidavit of Indigency for the above case and has approved for this Office to perfect the appeal for Mr. Brown.

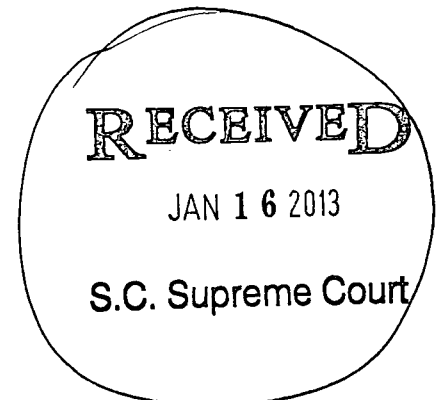


