MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR  
WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

Counsel for Kairon Brenton Maldonado respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. 
4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this




