MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR
WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Dominique Jarard Shumate respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until November 14, 2018**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.


