RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE FINAL BRIEF

On October 1, 2018, Appellants served on Respondents the *Plaintiffs-Appellants' Record on Appeal*. Pursuant to Rule 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the parties shall serve and file their final briefs within twenty (20) days after the service of the Record on Appeal.

Respondents hereby request an extension in which to serve and file their final brief. This extension is necessary because the *Plaintiffs-Appellants' Record on Appeal*, as compiled by the Appellants, does not contain "all material proposed to be included by any of the parties," as is required by Rule 210, SCACR. Instead, the *Plaintiffs-Appellants' Record on Appeal* contains only those materials proposed to be included by the Appellants.

Appellants have filed a *Motion to Strike Respondents Designation of Documents in Record on Appeal*. Respondents have filed a Return to that Motion, urging this Court to deny Appellants' motion to strike. This Court has not yet made a ruling on that Motion. Therefore, the Appellants' compilation and service of the Record on Appeal, which contains only those materials designated by the Appellants for inclusion, is premature and incomplete.


