Dear Mr. Bellamy:

This is to inform you that the Court has not received a motion to be relieved as counsel of record from Howell V. Bellamy, Jr., and Howell V. Bellamy, III. Since you are currently represented by counsel, the Court has not accepted your briefs or the record on appeal as filed. *See Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 347, 697 S.E.2d 527, 527 (2010) ("Since there is no right to 'hybrid representation' that is partially *pro se* and partially by counsel, substantive documents, with the exception of motions to relieve counsel, filed *pro se* by a person represented by counsel are not to be accepted unless submitted by counsel"). If you wish to proceed *pro se*, then you must file a motion to relieve counsel, pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. This appeal will not move forward until the matter of the appellant's representation is settled.
