

PETITIONER'S SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


Undersigned counsel moves this Court for an order granting Petitioner a Second Extension of time in which to file the initial brief and designation of matter in the above-captioned matter which are currently due on or before September 22, 2018. For the below reasons, counsel requests that this Court extend the deadline for filing the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix another seven days, or until October 29, 2018

To begin, undersigned counsel filed another Petition for Certiorari for a different client on October 10, 2018. Further, undersigned counsel's associate attorney who is assisting in this matter, was notified on or about October 5, 2018 that he had to fly to Fort Campbell in Tennessee on October 18, 2018 to represent a client in a contested military separation hearing on October 19, 2018. Further, the Appendix in this case is more than 800 pages and there are only two print shops in Beaufort, SC. Neither is open on the weekends and the print shop used by undersigned will not have the bound Appendices completed until October 22, 2018.

Also, during the last month, undersigned's office and the print shop closed because of storm related issues. In the case of the undersigned's office, his staff have 7 school age children out of school because of the storm resulting in the closing of the undersigned's office twice between September 10 and October 12, 2018. Five business days were lost during this time, causing further disruption and rescheduling. Finally, undersigned has communicated with opposing counsel about this request and the Respondent will suffer no prejudice as the Petitioner is incarcerated and serving his sentence at this time.

Therefore, undersigned counsel requests that the Court extend the deadline another seven days, or until October 29, 2018.



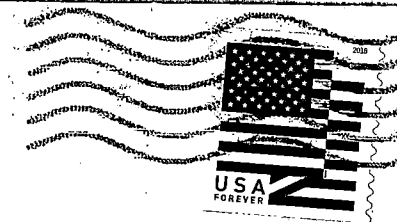
