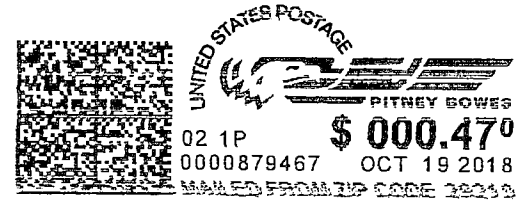
Mr. Shearhouse:
