I, ROBERT WILLIAM WAZNEY, applied for in forma pauperis in the above titled action (2018-001505). I received October 4, 2018 Order on October 10, 2018 denying in forma pauperis. I hereby state the following facts:

- 1.) This is an action for appeal of 2016-CP-43-00733 Judgments dated July 14, 2018;
- 2.) I am the applicant in this action and I believe I am entitled to redress;
- 3.) Because of inappropriate government interference by the incursion of pretrial freezing of my untainted assets as a criminal defendant effecting my poverty, I am unable to pay the costs of said proceeding or give security thereof;

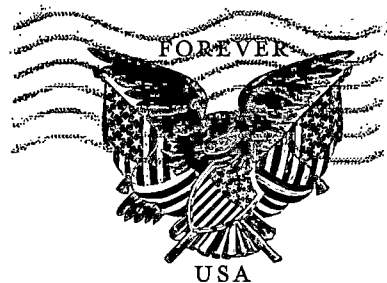
