

I am in receipt of this Court's letter dated October 16, 2018, noting deficiencies in the initial notice of appeal previously filed on behalf of my client.

With regard to the PCR court's ruling that Petitioner is not entitled to a belated direct appeal from his guilty plea, as an officer of the Court, undersigned counsel is unable to set forth a valid explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal. Accordingly, by copy of this letter, Petitioner is advised that he must, within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter, provide directly to the Supreme Court of South Carolina at P.O. Box 11330, Columbia, SC, 29211, an explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal and identify the issue(s) to be raised on appeal and the factual basis for the issue(s) including how the issue(s) was raised below and the ruling of the lower court on that issue(s). He is further directed that if an issue was not raised and ruled on by the lower court, he must include argument and citation to legal authority showing how this issue can be reviewed on appeal.


