
Dear Clerk Kitchings:

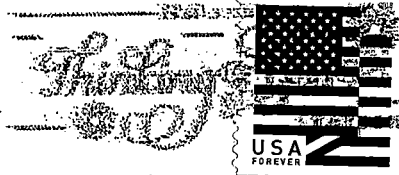
