MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Dominique J. Agurs respectfully requests an extension of thirty days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Dominique J. Agurs respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. On October 9, 2018, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Felix Kotowski before the Court of Appeals. On October 4, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Colette Adriane Collins with the Court of Appeals. On October 1, 2018, counsel testified by telephone in the post-conviction relief case of Jonathan Brown v. The State before the circuit court. From September 24, 2018 through September 26, 2018, counsel attended the annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 21, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Theodore Glover with the Court of Appeals. On September 17, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Jerell Jackson v. The State with this Court. On August 30, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Roderick Germaine Wynn v. The State with this Court. On August 24, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Nehemiah J. Evans v. The State with this Court. On August 20, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Andrew Allston Kirkland with the Court of Appeals. On August 9, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in James R. Glisson, Jr. v. The State with this Court. On August 1, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Benjamin J. Jackson v. The State with this Court. On July 26, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Russel Levon Johnson with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon


the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


