

ORDER

On October 24, 2017, this appellate case was dismissed by the Clerk of this Court. When no motion to reinstate was received within the time provided by Rule 260(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the remittitur was properly sent to the circuit court on November 9, 2017.

On November 16, 2017, this Court received a petition for rehearing from petitioner dated November 11, 2017. By letter dated November 20, 2017, petitioner was advised that no action would be taken on this petition for rehearing by this Court because the remittitur had been sent.

Petitioner has now filed a motion seeking leave to file a motion to reinstate. Since the remittitur has been properly sent ending appellate jurisdiction over this case,¹ the petition for rehearing and the motion for leave to file a motion to reinstate are hereby stricken and dismissed.
