ORDER

The South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC) has filed this appeal from the Administrative Law Court's (ALC's) order holding Respondent is eligible for parole, work release, or supervised furlough. SCDC has also filed a motion to hold this appeal in abeyance and a motion to remand this case to the ALC to correct an error of law in the underlying order. Respondent has filed a motion to appoint counsel. Due to the unique circumstances of this case, Respondent's motion to appoint counsel is granted, and the Office of Appellate Defense is appointed to represent Respondent on appeal. The timelines shall be stayed for thirty days for Respondent's counsel to serve and file any returns to the pending motions.
