## ORDER

Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is granted. The circuit court's October 19, 2018 scheduling order and October 22, 2018 order denying the Rule 59(e) motion are not immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330 of the South Carolina Code (2017). The scheduling order is not appealable pursuant to *Hagood v. Sommerville*, 362 S.C. 191, 607 S.E.2d 707 (2005), because the order does not disqualify Appellants' counsel. Further, this court lacks appellate jurisdiction to review Chief Justice Beatty's October 17, 2018 administrative order. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 14-8-200(a) (2017). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
