MOTION TO WITHDRAW





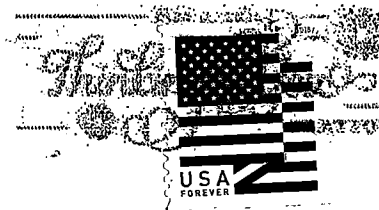
